

School District of Denmark-Curbside Meal Service Ending

Due to low participation, the District will discontinue no cost curbside meal service effective Monday, December 7th. Sites included are Denmark High School, All Saints and St. Johns.

Denmark in-school students will continue to not be charged for any meal. The Seamless Summer Option (SSO), which is funded by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and is administered by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction, provides nutritious meals to children. This option has been extended during the coronavirus pandemic when there may be an increased need to assist students.

Meals are provided to eligible children regardless of race, color, national origin, age, gender, or disability and there will be no discrimination in the course of meal service.
